Gilles Prud'homme is a World Class Master Carver who has been carving wildfowl for over 17 years. Using tupelo wood and acrylic paint, to create his exceptionally lifelike sculptures, Gilles captures the beauty and essence of his subject with great care and attention to detail.

Gilles' works have earned him numerous awards in Canada and United States. In 2009 Gilles earned 3rd Best in World Decorative Lifesize and 2nd People Choice Award. He also earned 1st Best of Show at The Canadian Nationals and 1st, 2nd & 3rd Best of Show at the Canadian Wildlife Carving Championships. To end a very successful 2009 Gilles' Pectoral Sandpiper was awarded 1st place at the North American Shorebird Carving Championships in Stone Harbor, New Jersey.

Gilles has a true passion for this art form and will continue to promote it by participating in shows, judging, performing seminars and encouraging future carvers.
